



## JURASSIC CLASSIC RULES

1. **No cash refunds will be allowed.** Once you pay on show day, money will be put in pot. Refunds allowed on early entries only as long as a vet or doctor release is received by midnight Wednesday September 1! All refund checks will be mailed the week after the show, minus a \$25 processing fee per horse.
2. A \$5 processing fee will be charged for all changes. Changes can only be made at show office beginning on 9/2/10, after 4:00 pm. Horse substitutions will be made, but there will be no preference for time or running position on the ground given. Riders may substitute. You may make time section changes at the show with a \$5 processing fee.
3. In the event of a timer failure, manual time will be used. If no manual time, a re-run will be issued. However, if the first run resulted in a knocked over barrel resulting in a no time, a re-run will not be granted. Re-run will be at the end of the time slot or at a mutually agreed upon time. If a contestant feels they have been fouled during a competition run, they must immediately declare themselves to the judge following their run. Judge's decision is final.
4. If there should be a tie, a coin toss will determine the winner.
5. All money winners from Saturday and Sunday are eligible for the saddle drawing.
6. 80% pay back, 100% added, payout 30%, 25%, 20%, 15%, 10%. The fastest time each day will determine the breakdowns. The breakdowns are as follows: 5D-fastest +  $\frac{1}{2}$  +  $\frac{1}{2}$  +  $\frac{1}{2}$  +  $\frac{1}{2}$ , 4D-fastest +  $\frac{1}{2}$  +  $\frac{1}{2}$  + 1.
7. Buckles will be awarded on Saturday and Sunday to the winners in the following classes: open 5D class 1D-5D, Pee Wee class 1D & 2D, Stick Horse class 1D & 2D. All 5D winners Saturday and Sunday will be entered in the drawing to win a saddle.
8. All incentive races will be carried over from open 5D times. Incentive races will be 4D.
9. All pre-entries will be taken in the order they are received in the mail by Expo Center staff. Requests for time slots will be considered based upon availability. Late entries will be drawn until a certain point, at which time late entries may be placed in the order you enter. Entering multiple horses late could result in runs being close. Enter early!
10. If there is a question to a horse's eligibility or racer's eligibility, the complaint should be made in writing to the show secretary with a \$50 deposit. Checks will be held in classes of complaint until contestant proves eligibility, but no longer than one week.
11. If a contestant acts in an un-sportsman like manner, they will be asked to leave immediately and no refund will be given.
12. Office will be open one hour prior to running times each day. Entries will be taken until the last 50 runners, at which time checks will be figured. No entries will be taken without payment. No early numbers will be given unless paid for.
13. Dress code is highly encouraged, but not required.
14. No un-stalled horses are to be left on grounds overnight.
15. Shavings must be purchased at the Expo Center at \$7.50 a bag. You cannot bring your own. There is a one (1)-bag minimum per stall. We are not responsible for unattended shavings. If you are not arriving during running hours, please call to have pre-paid stalls unlocked.
16. Time limit: if you are not able to get your horse into the arena after the 2<sup>nd</sup> call, you will be given 60 seconds to enter the arena. After 60 seconds, if the horse hasn't broken the plane of the arena at the alleyway; a no time will result.
17. NO DOGS ALLOWED INSIDE THE ARENA.
18. Other rules may be added if necessary. We try to be fair to everyone. If you have a question, please ask and we will try to

determine the fairest possible results.
